Dear SHA Family,



THE SAMIS FOUNDATION

In appreciation of the Samis Foundation.

We are abundantly grateful for the support and continuous contribution that enable us to realize our vision and mission of providing an excellent education to our children.

During his lifetime, Sam Israel believed in giving back. Born in 1899 in the Sephardic community of Rhodes, he and his family immigrated to Seattle in 1919. Shortly after arriving, founded a series of successful shoe repair businesses in downtown Seattle, eventually landing a contract to repair shoes for the United States Army. Sam invested his earnings in real estate amassing a significant portfolio of properties and assets currently valued at approximately \$180 million. Sam Israel established the Samis Foundation and appointed 18 lifetime trustees to govern the Samis Foundation. The Foundation continues Sam Israel's legacy through its support of Jewish education locally, and six program areas in Israel.



Connie Kanter is the Chief Executive Officer of Samis Foundation as of March 2019. She served as a Samis Board Member from 2010 to 2019, as Grants Committee vice-chair, and on the Finance and Audit, and Planning Committees. Prior stepping into her role as Samis CEO, she was the CFO/ Sr. VP, Finance and Business Affairs at Seattle University. Connie has served in a variety of leadership positions in the Jewish community including the boards of Jewish Federation of Greater Seattle, Kline Galland Center, and Seattle Hebrew Academy. She was a member of the UJC Young Leadership Cabinet and Wexner Heritage Program.
