A Covid positive student or staff member must stay home for 5 days from symptom onset or the date the positive test was administered. They may return to school Day #6 if there are no symptoms. If the Covid positive person does not isolate, household members will return after a negative test on Day #10 from when the Covid positive person started symptoms or tested positive. SHA will administer rapid antigen tests — parents reman in parking lot until results are known. No classroom quarantine.	Exposed child(ren) or staff test, rapid or PCR, may return with a negative result. Then test again on Day #5 past exposure, rapid or PCR. This may change depending on situation. Please let us know if you had an exposure.

SHA Travel Policy for Students & Staff

Step 1:

Upon return from travel out-of-state, students and staff, should test on the day of return at home, if the test is negative, and student / staff are symptom free, they may return to school the next day.

Step 2:

Test again on day #5, if it is a school day – school will test at drop off.

Continue to monitor for symptoms of all household members.
