If the Covid positive person does not isolate, household members will return after a negative test on Day #10 from when the Covid positive person started symptoms or tested positive. The class member parents are asked to keep a close eye for any symptoms and if your child does develop symptoms, be in touch with SHA's nurse. SHA TRAVEL POLICY FOR STUDENTS & STAFF

Upon return from travel out-of-state, students and staff, should test on the day of return at home, if the test is negative, and student / staff are symptom free, they may return to school.
