I am the parent or legal guardian of the Seattle Hebrew Academy student whose name is printed above.

I authorize the above student to participate in one or all of the following extracurricular activities by circling and initialing one or more of the following:

I further authorize the above student to compete against other schools in each of the extracurricular programs (circled and initialed above) at the Seattle Hebrew Academy gymnasium and other Seattle area gymnasiums and cross country courses. Given my child's participation in this SHA athletic activity, I have made the appropriate medical consultation and confirm that full participation in the above activity is authorized. The school should know that my student has (allergies to medications, medication being taken, bee sting kits, inhalers, etc.)?

As a parent, I agree: • the team bench during games is for

students only; • to be a fan and let the coaches coach and let the referees ref; • that my child and myself must respect the players/ coaches of our team and other teams at all times. I further understand that noncompliance of the above may result in my child being removed from a game program; • that practices are for players and coaches only.

I have explained to my child and we agree to the following:

1. My child must attend school for at least 1/2 day to be eligible to be able to a. play in a game on that day or b. be able to participate in a practice on that day.

2. The term "student athlete" means that academics come first. Students must maintain a consistent academic performance (relative to non sports season performance) during sports seasons. Failure to do so may result in suspension or dismissal from a team.

3. That my child's participation in the Interscholastic Athletic Program is not an excuse for neglecting the academic components of schooling: not an excuse for failing to complete assignments or failing to submit assignments when they are due. Nor is participation an excuse for postponing exams.

4. Decisions about playing time are made solely by the coach, and that the coach bases those decisions on a player's ability and not a player's seniority. (For example, a 6th grader may earn more playing time than an 8th grader or a 7th grader may start ahead of an 8th grader).

5. My child must always treat their coach with respect. Failure to do so, either in practice or games, may result, at the coach's discretion, in suspension or dismissal from the team.

6. If I or my child has concerns about the team or my participation, it is our responsibility, as a first step, to inform the coach and meet with the coach to discuss the concern. I understand that SHA is not in a position to provide transportation to athletic events, and that the latter must be organized and provided by the parents of participating students.

I understand that given the security concerns of SHA and of the Jewish Community in general, I will do my fair share to help out with gym door security during games.
