Since that day, SHA has reinforced our commitment to our core values, including providing a safe and secure campus, creating immersive learning opportunities for all our students, engaging our students in Torah study and deeply connecting them with Israel. Through tefillah, chesed, tzedakah, and activism, our school community, together with Jews in Seattle, Israel, and all over the world, have built an incredible sense of achdut (unity).

Our community recently celebrated SHA's storied history. For 75 years, SHA has provided an excellent Judaic and General Studies education, creating a lasting impact on our alumni and the greater lewish community. Our alumni are proud to be Jewish, to call Israel their home, to hold our values and traditions close, and to engage in building a bright Jewish future in Seattle and across the world.

Our new *After School Enrichment* and *Camp* **Shemesh** programs offer educational and play opportunities outside of the regular school day. Connected with our 75th Anniversary, we launched the Live.Learn.Play *Campaign* to renew, refresh and re-imagine many shared spaces.

To further strengthen our connection to Israel, SHA is thrilled to welcome the Yoavs, a shaliach family from Israel. Moreh Shahar and Morah Haggit Yoav and their children have made an incredible impact since their arrival in August.

SHA is also hosting another dedicated Shinshinit this year, Hallel Cohen. The Yoavs and Shinshinit Hallel, working together with our Judaic Studies and Hebrew language teachers, are building deep awareness of Israel and strong connection to the land and its people.

A strong school community augments all of our work and parent engagement is a major priority. Our PTO is flourishing with new and improved programming and parent volunteerism is increasing. This year, we offer regular Torah learning programs for parents including at Monthly Mifgash before Rosh Chodesh and as part of the quarterly EC Hop programs.

As we reflect on this year's achievements and on our school's remarkable journey, we are filled with gratitude for all our supporters. We are thankful to our generous donors including our critical partner, Samis Foundation, as well as the *J-Z Greenberg Education Foundation*. Your commitment has been instrumental to our success, and we look forward to our continued growth and the accomplishments that lie ahead.

NEW INITIATIVES



GESHER PROGRAM

In consultation with the University of Washington's Haring Center for Educational Inclusion and building on the foundation of our Learning Center Team, SHA launched the *Gesher Program* – our Student Services Department. As the name describes, this initiative creates bridges of support for our students and families to have successful educational experiences.
